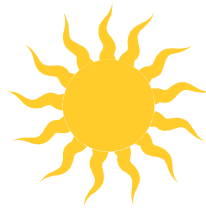


Homework!!!

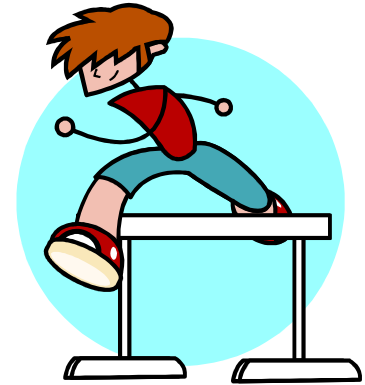


Physical Education.
