Thank you to all who supported this event and a special thank you to the few parents who helped plan and prepare for the event. It could not happen without them.

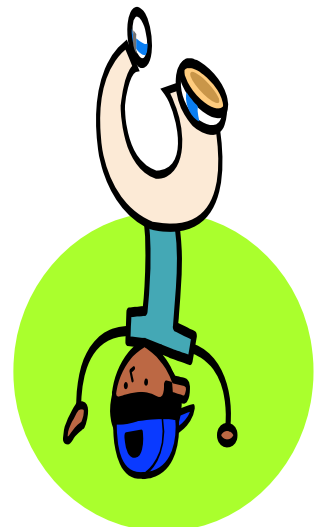
We raised over £400 pounds and the school council have decided to use it for playground markings. The children chose the designs.
