Spring Festival Assembly and Grand Easter Egg Raffle.

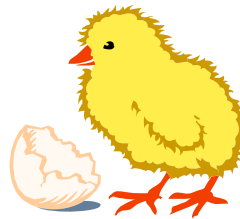

Thank you to all families who are walking to school. It really does make a difference to our car park, to the safety of your children and walking improves their health.

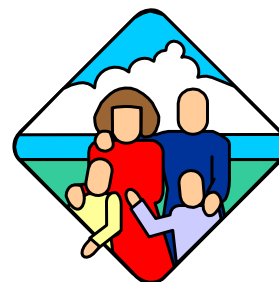
