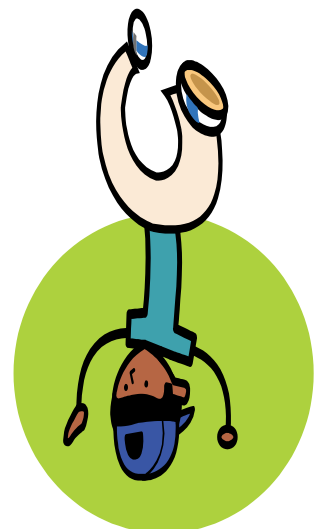
Swimming Pool.
