Dear Parents,

Here is the curriculum information for Key Stage 2 for this term. We hope it helps you to know what the children are doing in school this term and will give you an opportunity to support particular themes or topics. Below are some of the areas of learning that your children will be covering during the coming weeks.

English:

Revision for assessed writing in May as well as story writing, Poetry, developing ideas and imaginative planning, drafting, revising, proof reading, presentation skills, joined up handwriting, punctuation, adjectives, spellings, fluent and expressive reading, comprehension, book reviews, discussion, drama and role play.

Mathematics:

Revision for maths assessments in May as well as rounding numbers, mental problems, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Fractions and decimals, problem solving, data handling and measures including capacity.
Shape – position, reflection and rotational symmetry.

Science: Teeth and Eating – healthy and varied diet, functions of different teeth, dental hygiene.
Moving and Growing – skeletons / bones, differences in bodies, muscles and effect of exercise.
ICT: manipulating sound using ICT, using text and graphics.

Art: Portraying relationships through digital art – using images. Sketching people and experiment with photography.

Technology: Moving monsters project – investigating pneumatic systems.

Geography: Investigating the local area – maps/photos /fieldwork. Conducting surveys about peoples work and how/why they travel.

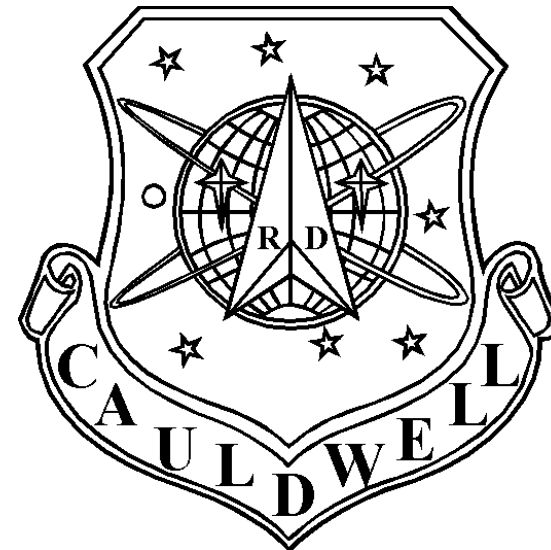
Music: Investigate melodic phrases, rhythmic patterns. Present class performances and singing games.
